

COOKIE POLICY

By means of the present cookie policy, FOUNDATION LOBBYING, BUSINESS&INNOVATION intends to inform you clearly and precisely about the cookies that are used on the website <http://icloby.org>.

Cookies are small data files that are generated, downloaded and stored in the user's browser and that allow the user himself to store the information generated by his activity on the network and allow the website to remember information about his visit to facilitate his next visit and allow the website to be more useful.

Thus, cookies allow the website to store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of a user or their equipment and, depending on the information obtained, can be used to recognize the user and improve the service offered.

The website <http://icloby.org> uses its own and third party cookies for the proper functioning of the website. You can allow their use or change your browser settings whenever you want.

Types of cookies.

Depending on which is the entity that manages the domain from where cookies are sent and treat the data obtained, we can distinguish between:

- **Own Cookies:** without those that are sent to the user's computer from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.

- **Third-party cookies:** those that are sent to the user's computer from a computer or domain managed by an entity that processes the data obtained through the cookies, but which is not the computer or domain of the editor.

There is also a second classification according to the length of time the cookies remain stored in the user's browser. These cookies are:

- **Session cookies:** these are designed to collect and store data while the user browses the website. They are normally used to collect data that is only of interest to keep for the provision of the service requested by the user on a single occasion (for example, the list of products purchased).

- **Persistent Cookies:** are those that collect and store data that remain stored on the device and can be accessed and processed for a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie and that can be a period of time from a few minutes to several years.

Finally, there is a third classification according to the purpose for which the data obtained through cookies are processed:

- **Technical cookies:** are those that allow the user to navigate through the website, platform or application and the use of the different options or services existing in this.
- **Personalization Cookies:** these are those that allow the user to access the service with some general characteristics predefined according to a series of criteria established in the user's computer.
- **Analysis cookies:** these allow the party responsible for them to monitor and analyze the behavior of the users of the websites to which these cookies are linked. The information collected through this type of cookies is used for the elaboration of browsing profiles of the users of the website. The user must be informed and consent must be given.
- **Advertising cookies:** allow the management, in the most effective way possible, of advertising spaces.
- **Behavioral advertising cookies:** they store information on the behavior of users obtained through the continuous observation of their browsing habits. This allows to develop a specific profile to display advertising based on it.
- **Cookies from external social networks:** these are used so that visitors to the website can interact with the content of different social networks, such as, for example, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn, Youtube, etc. and which are generated and stored only by the users of these social networks.
